<p>What did Coppice Performing Arts School do with the money?</p>	<p>Additional time allocation for English and Maths teaching (additional curriculum time and after school activities)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning Support Assistants dedicated to specific groups of students within Year 7 core lessons • Targeted Year Lead support, with specific responsibility for this cohort of students • Additional resources allocated to catch up provision • Leadership responsibilities allocated to drive reading across the curriculum, with provision for identified groups of students • Use of My Maths software to support learning at home
<p>How will the impact be measured?</p>	<p>Year 7 complete a series of common assessment tasks throughout the year and an end of year test in English and Maths, and progress will be monitored at each step. Where issues arise from CATs, addition support will be offered or support amended to ensure a greater impact</p>
